EUROPEAN CORROSION MEDAL - CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Dear Madam, Dear Sir,

The European Corrosion Medal, that distinguishes individuals with major contributions to the corrosion field and to the EFC mission, is to be awarded **every year**, on the occasion of EUROCORR, the annual event of the European Federation of Corrosion.

We would like to remind you to the fact that nominations for the European Corrosion Medal can be made only by **EFC Member Societies**, and that the Chairman of the STAC and members of the Jury for the Award are not eligible for nomination, as stated in the Rules.

It is now planned to award the **22nd European Corrosion Medal** on the occasion of **EUROCORR 2021** which will be held in **Budapest, Hungary, from 19 to 23 September 2021**.

We invite you to submit nominations for possible recipients by **February 25, 2021**. Each proposal should be accompanied with a motivation, brief curriculum vitae and a list of publications showing that the work of the candidate has been in conformity with the aims of the European Corrosion Medal Rules.

In order to facilitate the work of the Jury Members, an electronic version of the **EFC-Awards Nomination Form**, which should be completed and returned for each proposal, can be download from the Awards pages of the EFC website.

It would be appreciated if you could make use of the electronic form in order to facilitate the circulation of each proposal to the Jury Members.

I would be very grateful if you would give this matter your serious consideration and take the opportunity to propose candidates for this prestigious award.

Please remember that it is not mandatory to nominate new candidates each time nominations are sought. If you would like to re-nominate a previous candidate, all which is necessary is to update the original nomination form and accompanying documents.
